- Whereas, the Town of Beddington's Select Board and Planning Board have researched and reviewed the pros and cons of Industrial Solar Fields, and
- Whereas, said boards could find no positive benefits to allowing these Industrial Solar Fields in the Town of Beddington, and
- Whereas, said Boards could find no appropriate location where these Solar Fields could be installed that would preserve and protect the rural character of the town; to prevent and control water pollution; to protect fish, spawning grounds, aquatic life, bird and other wildlife; to protect buildings and lands from flooding and accelerated erosion; to protect archaeological and historic resources; to protect freshwater wetlands; to

control building sites, placement of structures and land uses; to conserve shore cover, and visual as well as actual points of access to inland waters; to conserve natural beauty and open space; to anticipate and respond to the impacts of development; to facilitate the economic and social way of life to promote public health, safety and general community well-being. and
